Motherboard CMOS Battery CR2032 - Statement regarding regulations UL2054 and IEC62133-2

## UL2054:

These requirements cover portable primary (nonrechargeable) and secondary (rechargeable) batteries *for use as power sources in products*. These batteries consist of either a single electrochemical cell or two or more cells connected in series, parallel, or both, that convert chemical energy into electrical energy by chemical reaction.

## IEC62133-2

Secondary cells (rechargeable) and batteries containing alkaline or other non-acid electrolytes - Safety requirements for portable sealed secondary cells, and for batteries made from them, for use in portable applications.

Based on the usage scenarios for the Kontron motherboards, the typically used CMOS battery CR2032 is not affected by above mentioned regulations.
